B uilt In 1810, The Daniel Wolf House is considered the birthplace of East Petersburg. In 1812, Wolf offered 79 building lots in a lottery – which established the town.

Local historians believe that the lottery was held in Wolf's general store. Being more than 200 years old, this historic property is now one of the town's oldest brick structures.

The location has been used as a school, a tavern, a hotel and as a butcher business.

December 16,1994: EPHS purchased The Daniel Wolf house & store at the corner of State and Lemon Streets. Since the purchase, the building has served as the official location of EPHS for activities and the collection of the town's history Items.

The Wolf House also serves as the EPHS Gift Shop. It has several items of interest for sale that include EPHS-branded clothing, replicas of many historical buildings in the borough, afghans and crocks.

Items from town artists include:

community building prints by Dorothy Hollinger, notes featuring artwork by Christian Strenge (a fraktur artist who lived in the borough during the 1790s until his death In 1828).
